PRODUCT: **Freehand 1281**

CONTENTS: 35% Wool, 28% Acrylic, 27% Polyester, 8% Spun Silk, 2% Nylon (70% Recycled Content)

USAGE: Eco-fabric, Upholstery

- Freehand is made from 42% post-consumer recycled content. Post-consumer waste is recovered from a material or finished product from the consumer supply chain (primarily from used textiles) that has served its intended use and has been discarded for disposal. Using recycled fibers preserves the resources needed to manufacture new fibers and reduces waste destined for landfills.
- Freehand is made from 28% post-industrial recycled content. Post-industrial waste is recovered from the production process at spinning mills that has been discarded for disposal.
- The mill that manufactures Freehand conserves energy by using solar power as an alternative energy source.
- Freehand is made with no known toxins or hazardous components.
- The overall contents of Freehand includes 35% wool and 8% silk. Wool and silk are a biodegradable, rapidly renewable resource.
- This product does not off-gas hazardous chemicals or substances into the air after installation.
- Recycled yarns are dyed in a yarn dyeing facility which conserves the use of water and other chemical substances.
